Treasurers annual report

Message from Lenka Page...

“Although I have thoroughly enjoyed my role as a PTA treasurer, I have decided to step down.

I would like to say a “Big Thank you” to all of you for giving up your time helping and supporting us in our fund-raising activities.

Personally, a “Big Thank you” to Sarah, Becky, Ellie and also Jo Sweales and Mandy Jenkins for all your hard work.

It gives me a great pleasure to tell you that this year with you giving us 30mins, 1hr, 2hrs of your very valuable time, we have successfully managed to build on the previous PTA’s efforts.

In 2018 the PTA funded:

Lower playground @ £4000
Yr 6 hoodies @ £460
Hazard Alley @ £540
School Pond plants @ £77
Total funding: £5,077

We are continuously trying to improve our fundraisers, but we have been very careful about how we spend the PTA’s funds during these events.

This time last year, we took over a bank balance of £4,550 but there was still a fireworks display balance payment of £1340 to be paid, leaving us with £3,210.

I am very happy to share with you today that our bank balance stands at £5,880 and 2018 fireworks display has already been paid.

In this we have £629 towards our "School Kitchen" project, £190 towards "Defibulator" project and £450 from McColls to spend on a worthy cause.

We have improved the PTA's cash position by a whopping £2,670.

Future funding and events

The school are still moving forward with there requests on what HS2 may be able to help fund in the future for the school.

The PTA now has the money to move forward in funding the defibrillator but before it is purchased the PTA needs to look into service plans and does it require on going further insurances also the PTA needs to look at the staff training. Community kitchen is an ongoing project the the pta will. Be offering some funds to the school in the future for this project to go ahead.

We are going to take a look into other pta funding resources as the co-op and Tesco have been a great help in raising funds for the PTA.

Our next event is fireworks and planning is well underway we kindly have Sponsors for this event.

We then went on to discuss ideas for future events so great ideas have been put forward:

- Big camp out
- Festival
- Race night
- Music bingo

We will be having a quiz type evening but not till later in the school year.

This year the events have been great success and it has been a great help dividing them up with there own event mangers and we will continue doing this into the new school year ahead.
